Dear Friends,

We are thrilled that in the year 2013, we achieved the highest productivity of any year to date. Childspring was able to serve a record number of 300 children in this year! Our coordinators and medical partners in South and Central America, Africa, Europe, Haiti, and the United States worked with us to change the lives of these children, and as a result we were able to help transform their communities.

A couple of our most important collaborations are in Colombia, where these highly successful partnerships allow Childspring to help children receive first-class heart surgery for as little as \$300. We are dedicated to supporting this success, and it was palpable at a board meeting in the fall of 2013 as Dr. David Watson, our Medical Committee Chair, passionately communicated of the 41 heart surgeries needed by the end of the year. The board collectively came together and sent out an email blast to their friends and family in an effort to raise the additional money needed. In just two weeks, Childspring received donations to cover all of the additional surgeries.

The year of 2013 was also our first year as a Turner Broadcasting Systems, Inc. grant recipient. Through this Turner Volunteer Day grant, Childspring received all of the supplies and volunteers needed to create First Aid Kits to send to our children and host families. Also this year, Childspring received a new grant through the Community Foundation for Greater Atlanta through the Extra Wish Fund. The grant provided us with brand new pediatric wheelchairs for children we treated. We were also able to purchase gift cards to send to our host families to help cover some of the expenses related to the children they are so lovingly caring for.

This year has been filled with many blessings: to see young Pedro, from Honduras, return home after successful scalp reconstruction surgery; to watch Zachary walk through the airport on his new legs; young Dillon see properly for the first time and be ready to read; know that Mateus from Brazil now struts across the room on two legs instead of struggling with one; and that Makenge, even before his treatment is finished, sees a completely different future for himself is inspiring. Each child received a renewed sense of pride and independence. Each gift is one that makes a significant impact. We were able to accomplish lasting miracles because of your continued generosity and belief in our mission; while always mindful of God's love and inspiration.







Almost 3,000 volunteer hours




And in-kind international donations and program services valued at \$6,160,569
